

FIRE DOOR SAFETY WEEK

5 THINGS TO CHECK FOR FIRE DOOR SAFETY



Look for a label, a

plug or similar

marking to show

that it's certificated

& follow the

instructions.



APERTURES

Altering the door for glazing apertures & air transfer grilles will make certification <u>VOID</u>.



GAPS & SEALS

Check the gap around the door frame is constant & around 3 to 4mm & CE marked hinges are firmly fixed with no missing screws. Ensure seals are fitted at the top & side of the door.



CLOSERS

Check that the closer shuts the door onto the latch from any position check from 75mm from the closed position.



Ensure the door closes correctly around all parts of the frame.

IMPORTANT: All ironmongery such as locks, latches, closers & hinges, MUST be CE marked & compatible with the door leaf's certification.
